As many of you know, Kent Nicholas

has been working hard on setting up an open water marathon swim in Arizona called the Arizona S.C.A.R. Swim Challenge: 4 days, 4 lakes, and 40 miles. He's seeking volunteer kayakers (or SUP boarders) for one lake or all 4 lakes – he's just happy to have you along. The swim has attracted some fantastic swimmers from all over so he's personally inviting you to be involved in this adventurous and unique event. Please know how appreciative he will be if you are able to join us.

WHAT IS THE S.C.A.R. SWIM? It is an open water marathon swim over the period of 4 consecutive days, 4 lakes and approximately 40 miles of beautiful wilderness. S.C.A.R., which stands for Saguaro, Canyon, Apache and Roosevelt lakes, has attracted some of the most adventurous open water swimmers from New York, Colorado, South Africa, Massachusetts, California, Connecticut and Ireland. Many are Triple Crown swimmers meaning they successfully swam the Catalina Channel (21 miles), the Manhattan Island Marathon Swim (28.5 miles) and the English Channel (21 miles). Kayakers can register to paddle as many lakes as they would like. There is a limited number of elite swimmers (25) and therefore a limited number of kayakers per lake (25). Preference given to kayakers that commit to all four swims.
